- 1. Press the MENU button to enter the **IMAGE SETTING**.

Using button 6 or button 7 to choose "BRIGHTNESS" or "CONTRAST" or "SATURATION" or "RESET" settings, use button 2 or button 4 to set the value. Use button 2 or button 4 to restore default settings;



2. Press the MENU button to enter the **GENERAL SETTING**.

Using button 6 or button 7 to choose CH1/CH2/CH3's "GUIDES" settings, use button 2 or 4 to turn on and off it. After trigger wire is activated, the parking lines will be turned on or off.

Using button 6 or button 7 to choose CH1/CH2/CH3's "DELAY" settings, use button 2 or 4 to turn on (1-15 seconds settable) or off it. After correspond trigger wire is activated, the triggered displayed image will keep showing for the set period (1-15 seconds) before switching to the default image.

3. Press the MENU button to enter the **SYS SETTING**.



Using button 6 or button 7 to choose the languages settings— English, Russian, Japanese, Korean.

Using button 6 or button 7 to choose the UPSIDE DOWN setting, use button 2 or button 4 to turn on or off it. If turn it on, you can install the monitor's U bracket to the ceiling of your vehicle.

Using button 6 or button 7 to choose MIRROR setting, use button 2 or button 4 to turn on or off the mirrored or un-mirrored function.
